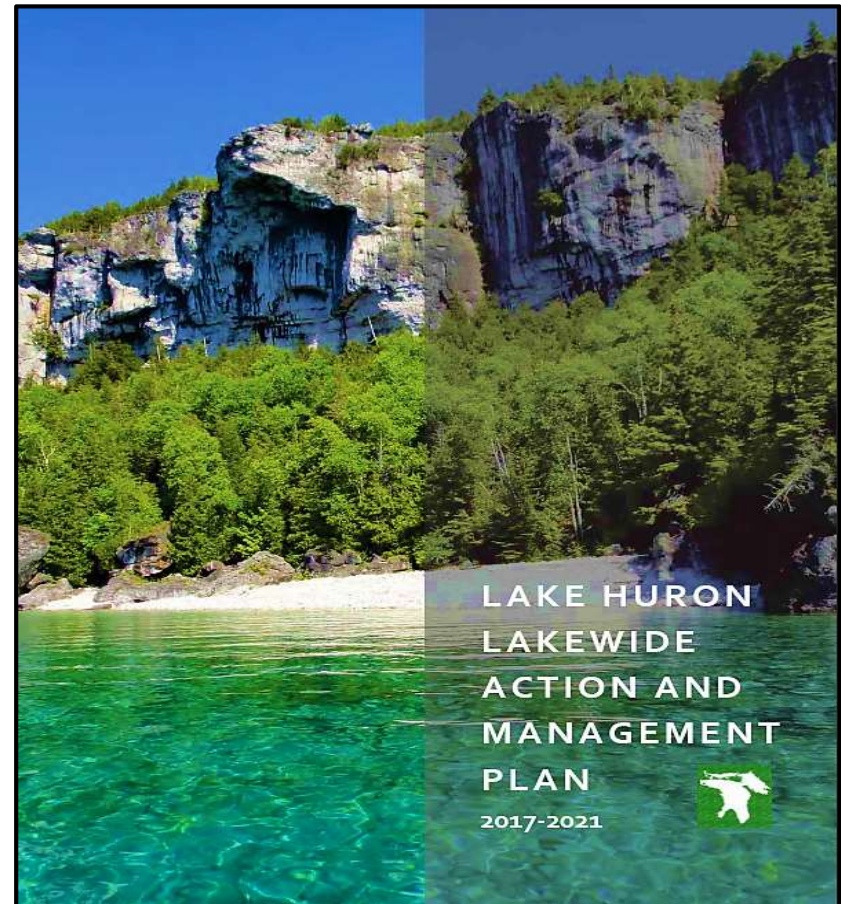

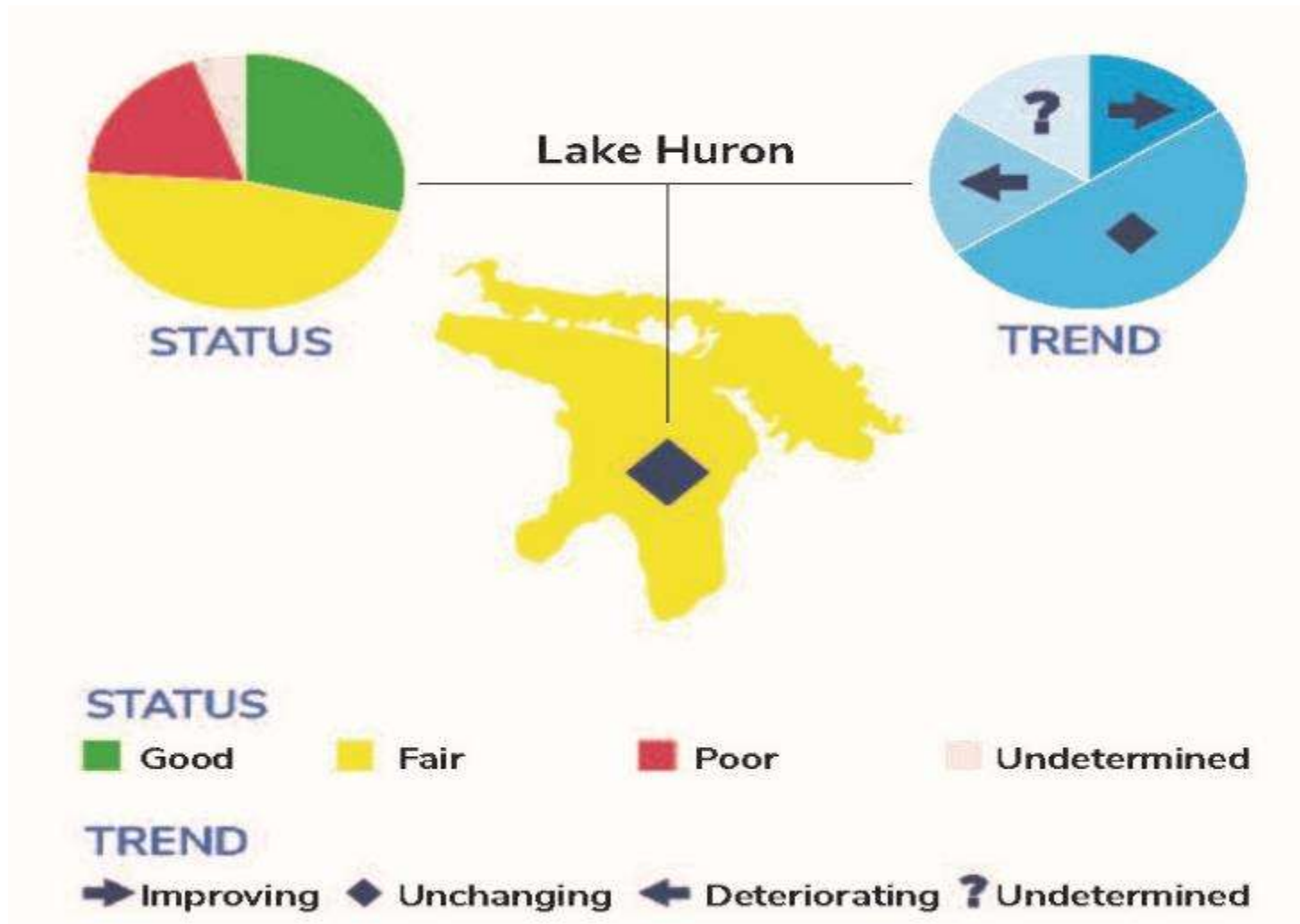

- Critical and Emerging Chemical Contaminants

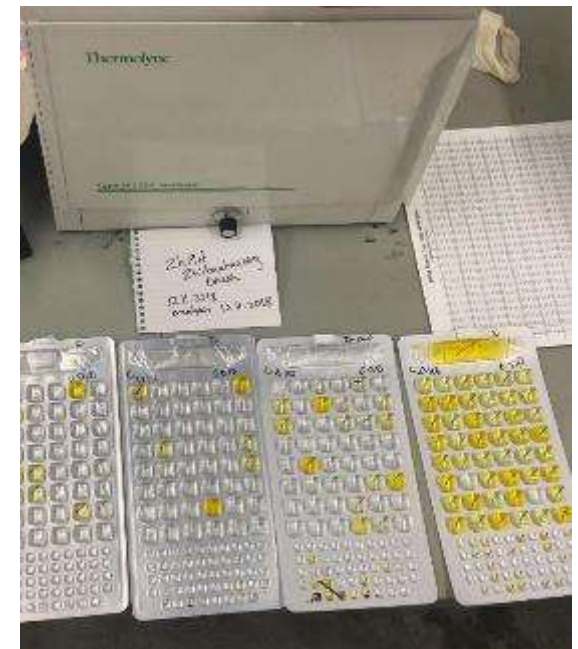
